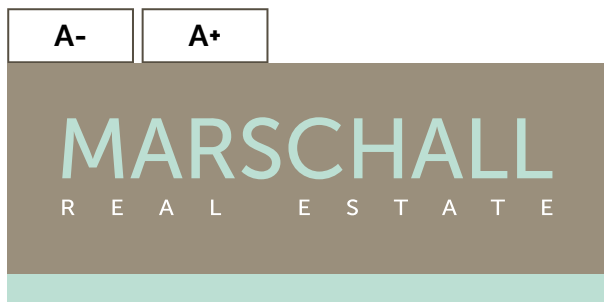




Historic Grand Villa - An Architectural Masterpiece in the Heart of the 19th District
